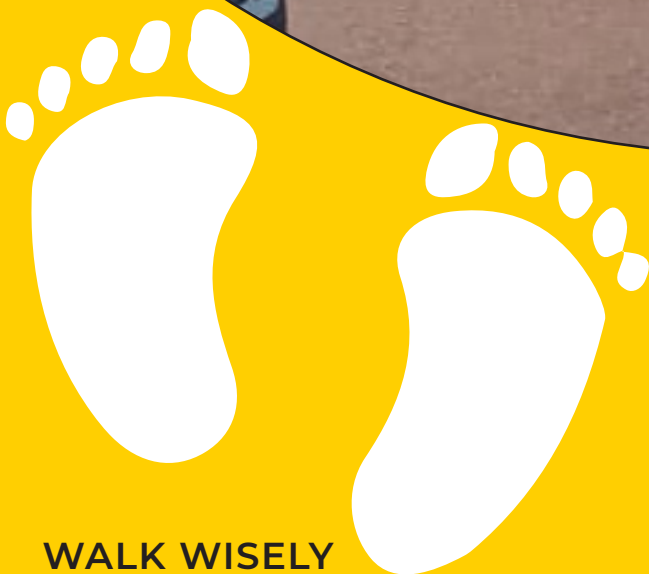

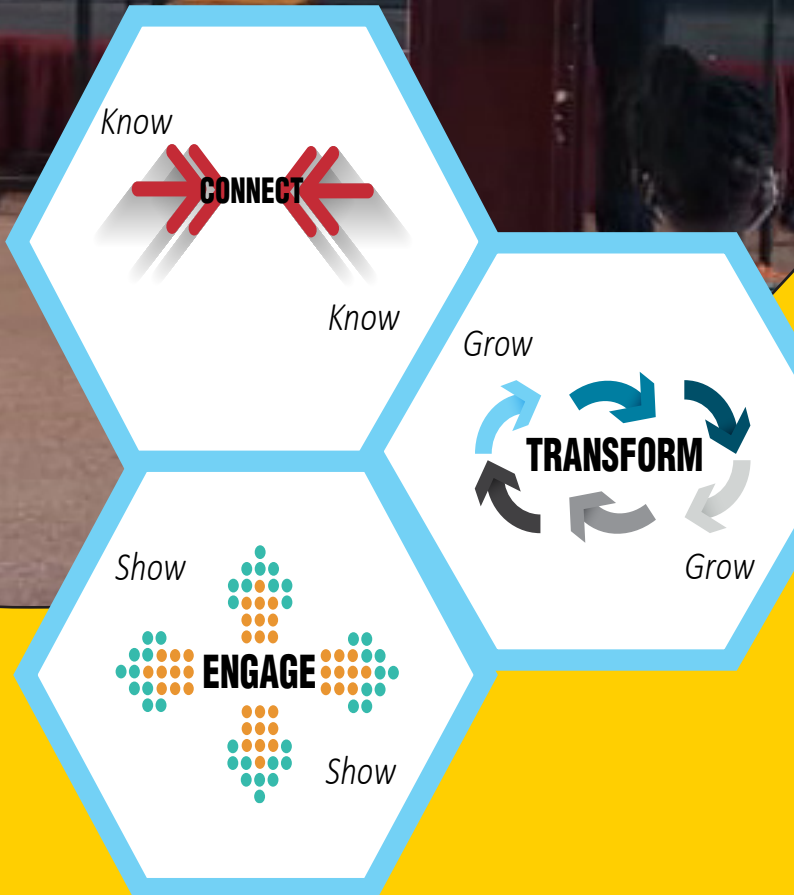

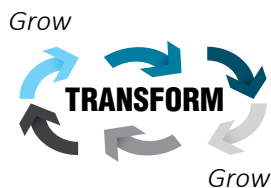

This year we are grateful to God for enabling us to run 2 Bible Institute intakes (January & August) as well as resuming onsite learning for the Christian school.

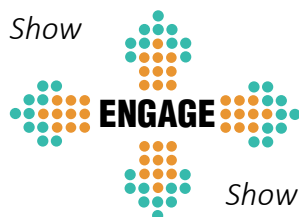
Continue to pray for the 21 students at the Bible Institute and 266 at the Christian school for heart transformation this year.
